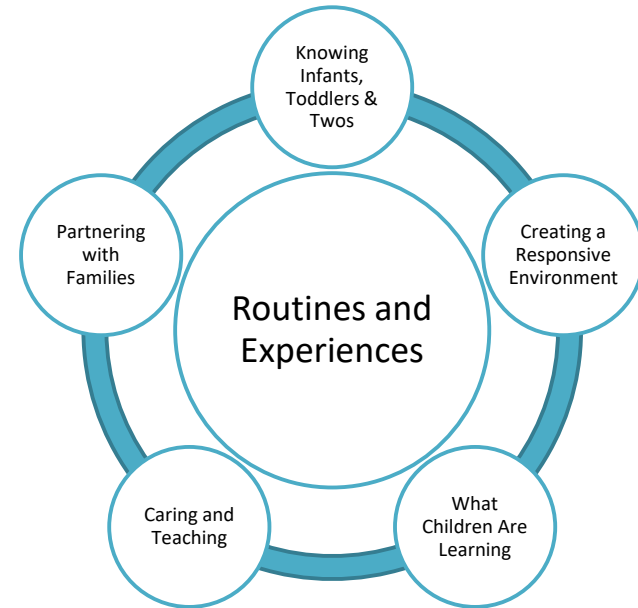
CREATIVE CURRICULUM FOR INFANTS & TODDLERS

RESPONSIVE CAREGIVING

Too often, the time spent diapering and toileting, feeding, dressing and helping children fall asleep are missed opportunities for development and learning. The Creative Curriculum helps use routine times to nurture children's curiosity, help them feel secure and create a language rich environment full of warm, loving and meaningful interactions. Social-Emotional Development TO LEARN ABOUT SELF AND OTHERS

- Trusts known, caring adults
