Scholarship Update

Our philosophy at HWCEC is that EVERY child should have equal access to high quality early childhood experiences.

We must meet our goal by April 1 (beginning of our fiscal year). On average we serve 40-45 families a year by providing a 40% or 50% reduction in tuition. In turn, these families volunteer 30 hours a year. We want to ensure we continue offering quality services to all members of our community.
